If not already a Member, I invite you to support our activities on behalf of residents by joining at a nominal subscription charge of £5 p.a. per household.

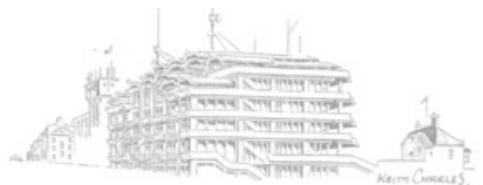
